MYCELIUM

What you see above ground are only the reproductive structures of fungi. Hiding in the soil or in decomposing material is mycelium, a huge network of hyphae. Present for much longer, the mycelium are like tiny roots that absorb water and nutrients that the fungus needs for growth. Different types of fungi can use their mycelium to decompose material, create beneficial partnerships with plants, or become parasites and attack organisms for their nutrients!
